Watering Guidelines

- Plants that "need no supplemental irrigation once established" usually don't need to be irrigated by the second or third summer after planting, and can usually survive strictly on seasonal rainfall.
- "Drought-tolerant" plants can survive with three to six deep soakings during a dry summer.
- "Regular irrigation" usually means weekly or bi-weekly for established plants during very hot weather; however, newly planted plants will need more frequent watering.
- 4. Water **young plants** more often, as they have small root systems and tend to dry out quickly. Older plants have established root systems with plenty of root hairs (the organs that collect the most water for the plant), so they do not need to be watered as frequently as younger plants.
- 5. When it's hot, dry, and windy, plants use up water rapidly. Young or shallow-rooted plants cannot absorb water fast enough to keep foliage from wilting.
- 6. **Container-grown plants** dry out more quickly than those in the ground. The soil volume in the pot is limited and it cannot store as much water. Some solutions are to transplant the plant into the ground or transplant it to a larger pot.
- 7. Try to locate **water-loving plants** near the house, while those needing less water should be planted progressively further away.

Trees That Should Not Be Grown Here

- 1. **Sissoo tree (Dalbergia Sissoo)-** Very invasive root system, grows extremely fast and large, unfortunately very highly recommended by nurseries
- 2. **Queen Palm-** Not suited for Yuma soils, requires too much water and care, messy
- 3. **Ficus-** Very messy, very invasive root system, not suitable for Yuma zones
- 4. **Glossy Privet-** very prolific from seed, invasive, very messy, requires too much water
- 5. **Melaleuca-** invasive, requires too much water, very prolific from seeds
- 6. **Tropical Ash/Shamel Ash-** requires too much water, grows too big (up to 80 ft. tall)
- 7. **Arizona Ash-** Very wide spread (45 to 60 Feet) by 30 feet tall, very messy
- 8. **Blue Wattle Acacia-** extremely invasive and prolific
- 9. **Boxwood-** High water requirements, not suitable for Yuma zones
- 10. **Mexican Palo Verde/Jerusalem thorn tree-** Very messy, naturalizes aggressively, considered a noxious weed
- 11. **Western Redbud tree-** Not suitable for Yuma zones
- 12. **Eastern Redbud tree-** Not suitable for Yuma zones, short lived
- 13. **Italian cypress-** very messy, fast growing to over 100 feet tall
- 14. **Ilex altraclarensis "wilsonii"** Not suitable for Yuma soil
- 15. **Lagerstroemia indica** not suitable for Yuma zones, messy, requires too much water
- 16. **Lysiloma watsonii "thornberi"** very messy
- 17. **Nerium oleander-** invasive, very poisonous, viral disease from the Sharpshooter insect that is killing the trees.

- 18. **Podocarpus macrophyllus "Maki" (ONLY)-** not suitable for Yuma soil
- 19. **All Prunus ssp**.- Not suitable for Yuma zones or Yuma soil, requires too much water, and heat intolerant
- 20. Pyrus kawakamii- Not suitable for Yuma zones, requires too much water
